## Maths

This term the children will be learning about Decimals. They will also continue with their speedy tables on a daily basis and their reasoning problems.

# <u>English</u>

In English, Guided reading will continue on a daily basis and weekly spellings will be sent home on a weekly basis.

In English the children will write stories that have an adventure theme and continue with learning how to write paragraphs, use emotion words to start sentences and learn how to use the possessive apostrophe.

#### Science

Our Science topic is to learn about Living Things. In this topic, children will learn how living things can be grouped using a classification key and they will also learn how the changes in environments can cause dangers to living things.

### History and Geography

In our Rivers topic the children will learn about where a river begins and ends, then identify the main rivers in the world and in the UK. They will also learn about the river environment, flood plains and pollution.

This term our topic will be looking at abstract water patterns and they will also learn how to create drawings of movement using shading techniques.




Please listen to your child read regularly- little and often is the key!
