Years 2, 3, 4 and 5 Information Update

Dear Parents/Carers,

From June 1st we invited some of our children to return to the academy. As you will be aware, the academy has been limited to key worker children, EYFS, Year 1 and Year 6 pupils. We would now like to be able to offer pupils in other year groups a small amount of time in school with their class teacher before the summer break.

Due to the current restrictions and the safety of our pupils being paramount, in order to invite other year groups it is necessary for us to end the term for EYFS, Year 1 and 6 on <u>Friday 10th July</u>. This will release staff from other groups and give us the space we need to have other bubbles on site safely.

We are currently finalising plans for Years 2, 3, 4 and 5 to be split into bubbles and to have an allocated day and time to be with their class teacher and some of their peers; giving them the opportunity to end the academic year before the new term in September. The bubbles will be as small as possible and the measures outlined in the Academy re-opening plan will continue to apply.
